

MARSHALLTOWN PROFILE

History

The Sac and Fox Indian Tribes signed a treaty with the United State government in 1842 opening up the rich and fertile soil of what is now Marshall County for settlement.

A decade later, Henry Anson, Marshalltown's first settler, decided to build a town on the divide between the Iowa River and Lynn Creek.

Anson named his settlement Marshall after a town he had visited in Michigan, and by 1853, the village was platted and the name recorded. The name was changed to Marshalltown in 1862.

By the dawn of the 20th Century, Marshalltown was an established city and home to many industries that developed into major national and international companies such as Fisher Controls and Lennox Industries.

State Sales Tax: 5% on personal property except food, prescription drugs and medical devices; an additional 1% local option sales tax and 1% school local option sales tax is collected in Marshalltown for a total of 7% sales tax.
